WHAT IS A CATHEDRA?

The cathedra is the Bishop's special chair found in his cathedral church. The word cathedra means "chair" or "seat" of teaching. It's a sign that the Bishop is the chief teacher and shepherd of the Diocese. When he sits on it, he speaks with authority as the leader of his flock. That's why the church where it's placed is called a cathedral, because of the cathedra. So, the cathedra isn't just furniture; it's a symbol of the Bishop's duty to guide and teach his people.
